## COVID-19:

## CAR PARKING - WALTON GARDENS

The main visitor car park will be reserved for blue badge holders only (up to 300 cars), a further 700 spaces are available on the grass overspill car park (this can involve a journey of up to 700m to the event site). A dropping off point is available adjacent to the bridge.

## PARK & RIDE

An accessible, free, Park & Ride Shuttle Service will be operating from 9.30am from Wilderspool Park (off Greenalls Avenue, WA4 6HL) - last bus from Walton Gardens 4.45pm.

## BUS SERVICE

An accessible, free, bus service will run every 30 minutes from 9.30am from Warrington Bus Interchange - last bus leaving Walton Gardens at 4:45pm.

## SUPPORT SERVICES

40 wheelchairs will be available on FREE loan at the entrance.

Unisex wheelchair accessible toilet units will be available around the event site (one includes a Hoist and Changing Plinth - RADAR key required).

BSL Interpreters will be available.
